

Band Parents Volunteer Hours Program

All band students at West Kings are required to have their families contribute to the Band Parents Association by donating an item to the bake take at the Annual Craft Fair and by performing volunteer work for the Association.

With the Band Parents Volunteer Hours Program families are asked to contribute 12 hours of volunteer work for the first student in band or a total of 20 hours of volunteer work if they have more than one student in band.

Should any family not wish to participate in the Volunteer Hours Program, they are then required to pay at a rate of \$10.00 per hour once again, depending on the number of students they have in band. For example, \$120 is required for the first student in band or a total of \$200 is required for two or more students in band.

Most of the volunteer work supports our fundraisers, which in turn supports the band program. Money raised goes to a variety of things including purchasing and/or repairing instruments, providing scholarships for band students and providing subsidies for band trips.

Any students who families do not participate will not be eligible to receive scholarships or band trip subsidies from the Band Parents Association.
